Matter arising:

ANGAD SINGH: Content of the latter from Anged Singh was discussed and it was decided that the secretary should acknowledge the receipt of the letter. It was further agreed that that being a matter between Anged Singh and the Woolgoolga Gurudwara Priest Kuldeep Singh and some members of the congregation, and the Sikh Council had no right to interfere in the internal matter of its member Association unless the Association asks for assistance, no action should be taken, and the matter should be referred to the Executive of the Sikh Gurudwara Woolgoolga and solicit to resolve it.

PROGRESS REPORT ON TEJA SINGH vs. RTA: The Secretary reported that after receiving e-mail from Constable Cheryl Johnson of Coffs Harbour Police Station he again wrote to CRC and the Minister of Police to resolve the matter and having not received any further response from either of them, he has written to the Premier Hon. Bob Carr to intervene to resolve the matter. Secretary further reported that he then received a call from Mr. Sassoon Gregorian Premier's advisor confirming that the Premier had received his letter and had initiated the action.
